



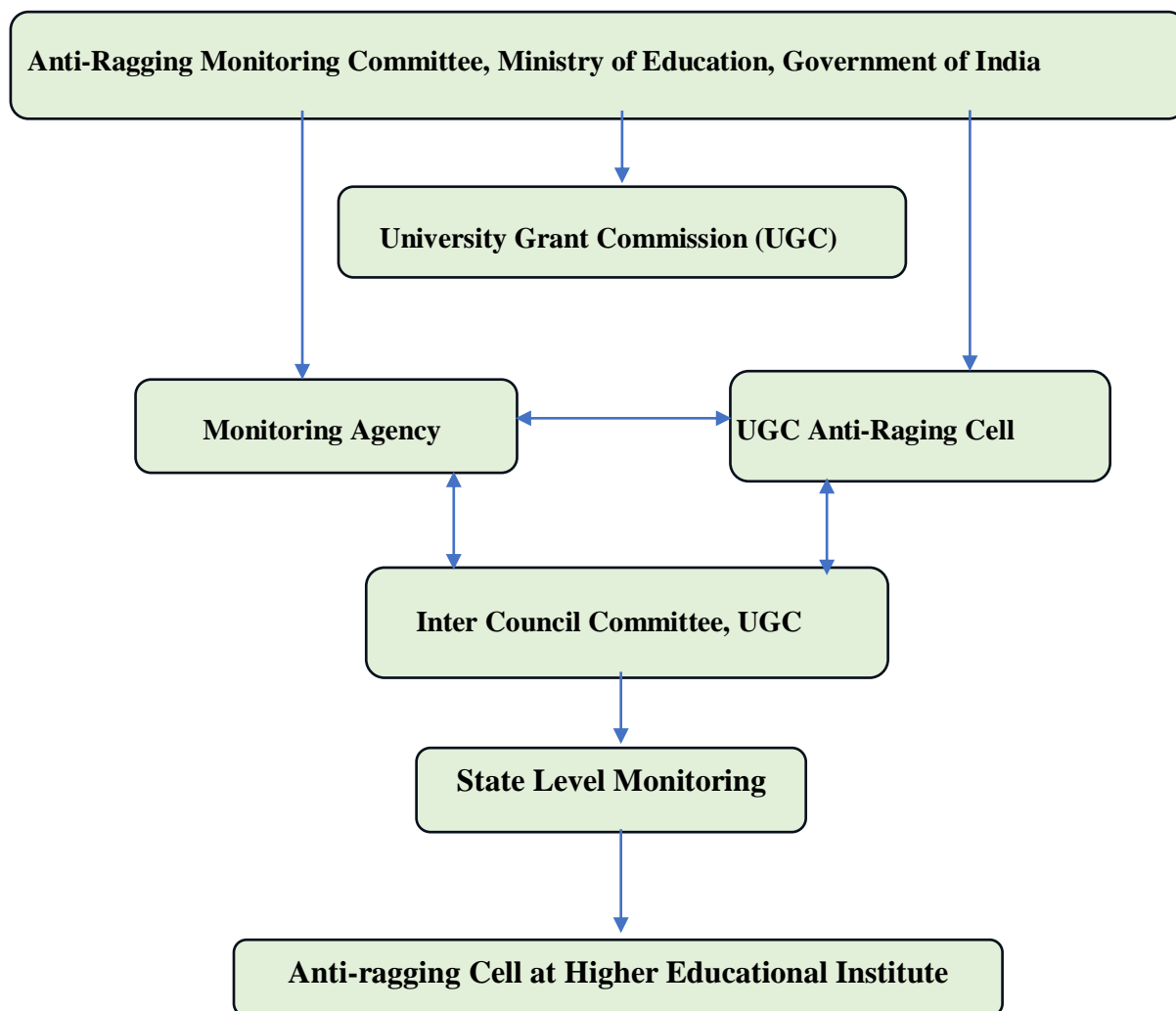

INTRODUCTION:

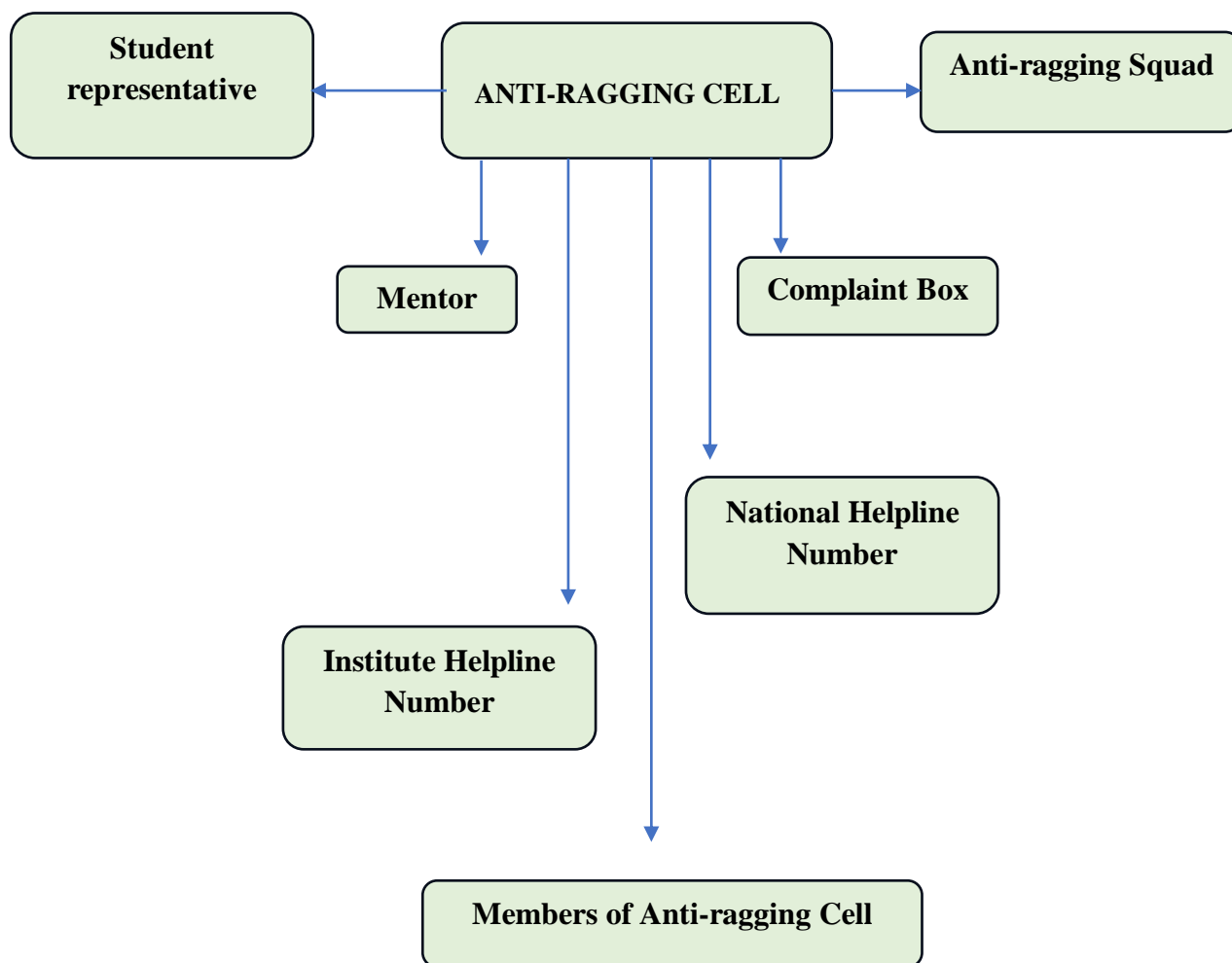
Government/University Grants Commission (UGC) guidelines notified vide no.F.1-16/2009 (CPP-II) dated 21-10-2009 on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 (Under Section 26(1) (g) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956) to curb the menace of Ragging at Higher Educational Institutes and Premises.

FUNCTIONS:

- To prohibit and address any and all forms and instances of ragging in the college and hostel premises.
- To educate the students on matters of ragging as a menace and the legal aspects of Anti-ragging act.
- To take necessary and required measures to prohibit ragging activities.
- To counsel students for prohibiting them from indulging, actively or passively in any ragging activity.
- To punish those who indulge in ragging as provided in regulations.
- To monitor and oversee the performance of the Anti-Ragging Squad in prevention of ragging in the Institution.
- To submit report to affiliating University on the matters pertaining to Anti-ragging Cell.

PUNISHMENTS:

Depending upon the nature and seriousness of the offence as established by the Anti- Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:-

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits
- Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process
- Withholding results
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel
- Cancellation of admission
- Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period
- Fine ranging between Rupees 25,000/- and Rupees 1 lakh
- Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.
