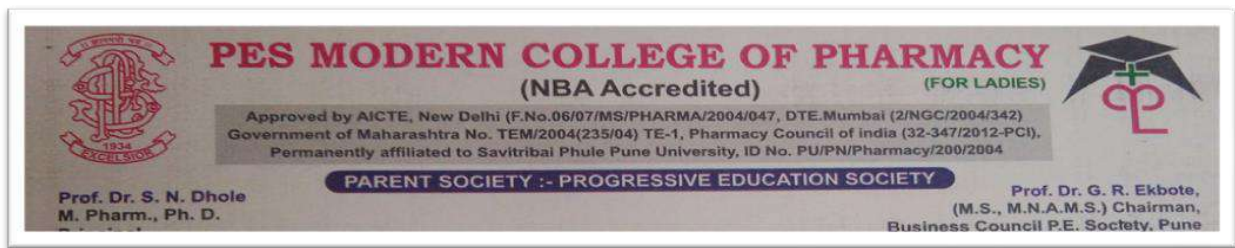


• EXAM POLICY FOR B.PHARMACY PROGRAMME

- Preparation of Examination Planner including Assessment and Sessional.
- Tentative Sessional exam dates will be communicated to faculty and students when college reopens for each semester.
- Savitribai Phule Pune University examination form filling dates and fees will be displayed on notice board at the start of each semester.
- For 2019 **Two** Sessional and if necessary one improvement Sessional will be carried out.
- At least 60% syllabus must be covered prior to first sessional examination.
- 100% syllabus must be covered before commencement of second sessional.
- Guidelines from Savitribai Phule Pune University question paper setting must be followed while preparing the sessional question paper.
- Question paper must be thoroughly checked and approved by head of the department for difficulty level, syllabus covered and CO-PO mapping before submission.
- CO1 , CO2 for first sessional and CO3,CO4 for Second sessional should be mapped.
- CO1 and CO5 should be mapped for Continuous Assessment.
- Question paper should be set to test the knowledge, memory, cognitive, analytical and reasoning ability of students.
- Question paper should be submitted before the scheduled date of the examination in a sealed envelope.
- Quality Question Paper should be submitted along with the Model Answer of the same.
- Assessed papers should be shown to the students along with feedback
- Assessed papers must be submitted within 10 days of the complete assessment and marks entry must be done in the register.
- Result analysis should indicate percentage of students securing 80% or > 80%, 60-79%, 50-59% and <50% and same should be entered in the soft copy provided by exam section.



- Publish the attainment level of the internal and external examinations as per the set threshold and weightage.
- Submit the signed attainment hard copy to exam section.
- During submission follow the checklist for submission of internal and final submission provided.
- Mark entry in the Internal Marks Entry Register should be done before entry to the SPPU portal.
- Marks of all assessments and final scores should be communicated to the students before submission of marks to SPPU.
- For the Self Appraisal following marks criterion should be considered

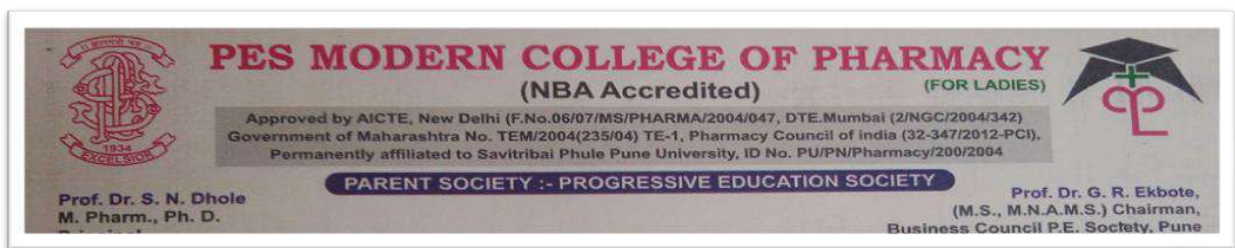

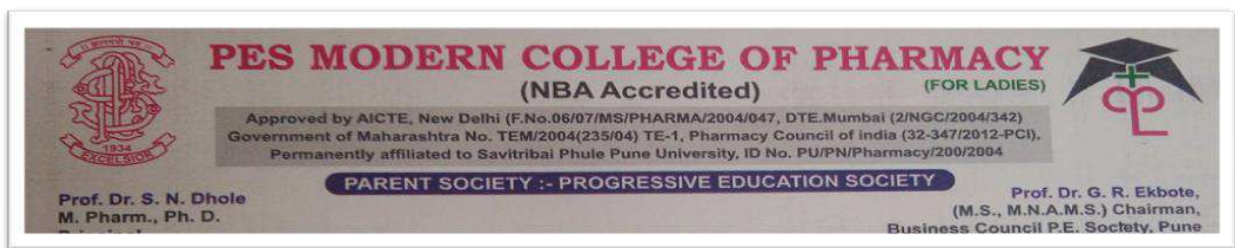

- Seminar

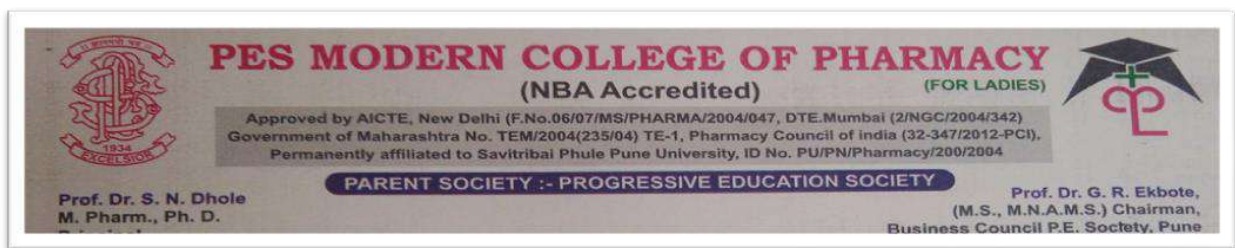
