STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE FOR PLANING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF CURRICULUM AND CONTINOUS EVALUATION

B PHARM

- Design the Course Outcomes (COs) based on course objectives and weightage of topic in the syllabus. Undergraduate courses must have five COs for theory and four COs for practical courses.
- Prepare the course plan (for 45 lectures and 15 tutorials) considering the Hrs assigned in the syllabus as well as actual number of lectures required for delivery of contents.
- Planner for practical courses should be prepared for 15 practical turns including two sessional examinations.
- First internal continuous theory assessment should be planned after completion of 20% of syllabus or 18-20 academic days.
- At least 40% of the syllabus should be covered before First sessional theory exam which is normally conducted after 35-40 academics days. Slow and advance learners should be identified after evaluation. Corrective actions to be taken.
- For practical courses, 45-50 % of experiments should be covered before First sessional examination.
- 7. At least 85% of the syllabus should be covered before Second sessional theory exam which is normally conducted after 75-80 academics days. Slow and advance learners identified should be reviewed after evaluation. Corrective actions to be taken if required.
- For practical courses, 90-95 % experiments should be covered before Second sessional practical exam.
- Second continuous theory assessment should be conducted after completion of 100 % syllabus and at the end of academic calendar.
- 10. The entire syllabus should be covered and all COs should be attained in 45 lectures or 15 experimental turn and 90 academic days.
- Tutorial sessions should be used for revision of topic taught in each week as well as for conduction of internal assessments.
- 12. Practicals should be assessed on daily basis.
- Content beyond syllabus identified from gap analysis should be covered appropriately for both theory and practical courses.
- 14. Attendance of students should be recorded on daily basis.
