STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE FOR PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF CURRICULUM AND INTERNAL ASSESSMENT PHARM D

- Design the Course Outcomes (COs) based on course objectives and weightage of topic in the syllabus.
 Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm D) courses must have six -nine COs for theory and four COs for practical courses.
- Prepare the course plan (minimum for 60 lectures / 90 lectures and 30 tutorials) considering the Hrs
 assigned in the syllabus as well as actual number of lectures required for delivery of contents. Includes
 at least one session for beyond syllabus to bridge the curriculum gap.
- Planner for practical courses should be prepared for 30 practical turns excluding three sessional examinations. (Includes at least one turn for beyond syllabus to bridge the curriculum gap).
- 4. First sessional examination should be planned after completion of 30% of syllabus or 55-60 academic days. Slow and advance learners should be identified after evaluation of first sessional examination. Corrective actions to be taken.
- 5. For practical courses,40 % of experiments should be covered before First sessional examination.
- 6. At least 75 % of the syllabus should be covered before Second sessional theory exam which is normally conducted after 115-120 academics days. Slow and advance learners identified should be reviewed after evaluation. Corrective actions to be taken if required.
- 7. For practical courses, 75-80 % experiments should be covered before Second sessional practical exam.
- The entire syllabus should be covered and all COs should be attained in 60 / 90 lectures or 30 experimental turn and 200 academic days.
- Tutorial sessions should be used for revision of topic taught in each week as well as for conduction of internal assessments. (Minium 30 tutorials).
- Practical should be assessed on daily basis.
- Content beyond syllabus identified from gap analysis should be covered appropriately for both theory and practical courses.
- Attendance of students should be recorded on daily basis. Minimum 80 % attendance is mandatory to appear for the examination.
